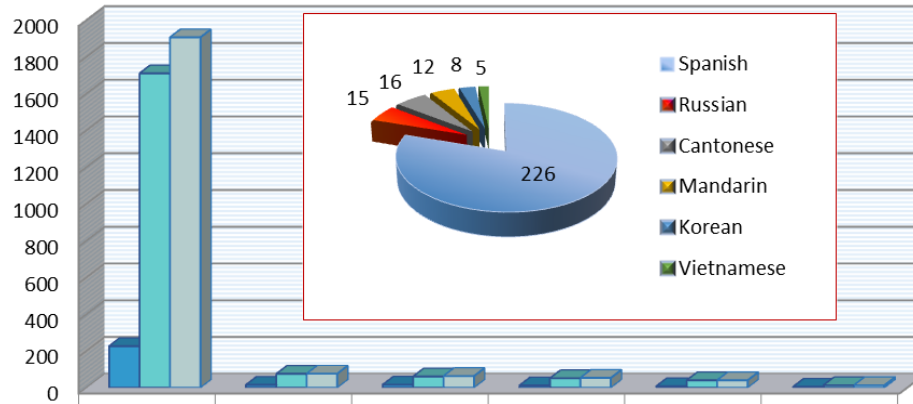


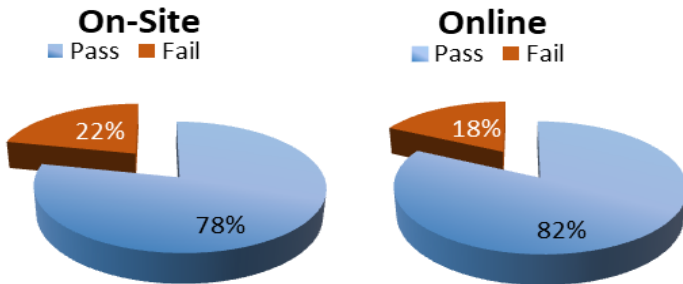
**Medical Interpreters Certified 2017**

Active certifications are those CMI credentials that are not expired, either because the original expiration date has not yet been reached or because the interpreter chose to recertify (renew the credential rather than allowing it to expire). Total certified to date includes all CMI credentials that have been issued by the National Board in each of the six languages as of 12/31/17 (both active and expired).

**Written Exam Testing Methods 2017**



CMI candidates can take the written exam either on-site at a PSI Services testing center or online through ProctorU.

In 2017, the National Board delivered 679 written exams (544 pass, 135 fail). Overall Pass percentage: 80%.

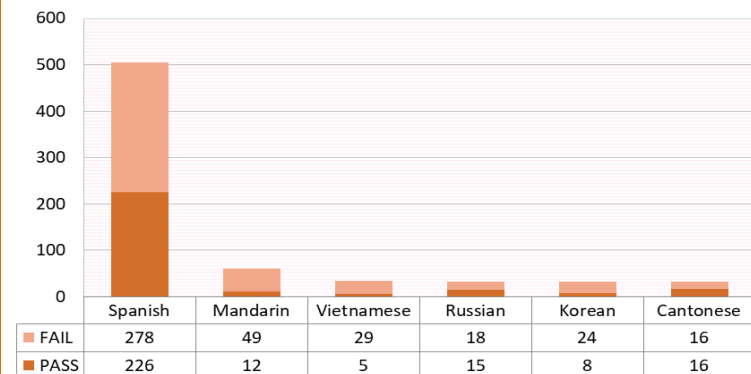

**Oral Exam Statistics 2017**



In 2017, the National Board delivered 696 oral exams (282 pass, 414 fail). Pass percentages: Spanish 45%, Mandarin 20%, Vietnamese 15%, Korean 25%, Cantonese 50%, Russian 45%.
