The Board is also actively seeking 2-3 directors from the public sector (doctors, hospital administrators, bilingual nurses, accountants with non-profit experience, professional grant writers, etc.); you need not be an interpreter to apply for these director positions, although professional experience in healthcare, language access, or non-profits is required.

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### **Eligibility and Commitment:**

\* Only Certified Medical/Healthcare Interpreters are eligible to serve on the National Board, although we are looking for non-interpreter public sector director nominations as well.

\* Previous experience serving on a Board of Directors is preferred, but not required.

\* Membership requires a minimum commitment of 5 hours per month, including a monthly meeting (via conference call).

### **Responsibilities:**

\* Attend board meetings and other meetings regularly called by the Executive Committee of the National Board.

\* Make a serious commitment to participate actively in Board and committee work; volunteer for and willingly accept assignments and complete them on time; stay informed about committee matters, prepare well for meetings and review and comment on minutes and reports.

\* Participate in fundraising efforts for the organization.

\* Abide by the Bylaws of the International Medical Interpreters Association and by the Policies and Procedures of the National Board.

150-word essay, which states agreement and commitment to the job description above and why board members should vote for you.
