



## WARNING: E-MAIL SCAM

It has been brought to the National Board's attention that a scam email had been sent to the interpreter's community using our logo requesting a donation for a member's son in desperate need for help.

The NBCMI needs to inform the public that we do not get involved in anything requesting the community for money deposit, transfer, donations, of any kind. There are formal and respectful agencies dedicated to support community needs.

This particular email was never originated by us, and it is a horrendous email fraud scheme, trying to trick our compassionate and novel medical community. Unfortunately, our website has a Registry open for consultation for employers seeking Certified Medical Interpreters.
